FINAL Livestock Check Pickup - Monday, October 10, 6-8 PM



4-H Advisor and Parent Updates:

It is that time of year again when we start recruiting new 4-H volunteers! A 4-H Volunteer is any adult who helps with the 4-H program in any way on a regular basis. These may be "parents", "helpers", "committee members", or "advisors". However, whatever you call them, they must be an approved Ohio 4-H Volunteer, have an application on file in the Extension office. complete an interview, and have passed an Ohio BCI fingerprint background check.

Anyone interested in becoming a 4-H Advisor or volunteer must fill out an application and be approved as an Ohio 4-H Volunteer before they can begin working with a club or committee.



4-H Enrollment time is coming up soon! Starting **November 1**st, members and advisors can begin enrolling!

Interviews will be scheduled following reference checks, at which time applicants will be given information on how to complete the background checks. Orientation meetings will be held after the first of the year. All new volunteer applications are due by January 31, 2022.
