Heifers can be shown in either Market or Breeding Class--NOT both.

<b>Dairy Feeders</b>	May 3rd	Weigh-In ~ Saturday, May 4th Jackson County Fairgrounds (9-11am)	<b>Maximum Weight 700 lbs; Minumum Weight 400lbs;</b> Born between Dec. 1st & Mar. 1st; Maximum of 2 DMF Shown; Castrated, Horns Allowed Up to 2 inches
<b>Market Lambs</b>	May 3rd	Weigh-In ~ Saturday, May 4th Jackson County Fairgrounds (9-11am)	85-155 lbs.; Born After Dec. 1st; Maximum of 2 Shown; Horns Allowed Up to 2 inches, Castrated before reaching 75 lbs, Lifiable Dock
<b>Breeding Sheep</b>	April 15th	Breeding Registrations Due June 15	Maximum of 2 entries per class; Must have a Lifiable Dock. Horns of any length allowed if it is part of the breed standard.
<b>Market Goats</b>	May 3rd	Weigh-In ~ Saturday, May 4th Jackson County Fairgrounds (9-11am)	60 lb. Minimum & Born After Dec. 1st (Market); Maximum of 2 Market Goats Shown; Male Goats Castrated; Horns of any length allowed on goats only.

Cannot be comingled with other birds after pullorum testing. <b>Breeding Turkeys must be purchased from a Pullorum-Free facility (must provide documentation) or have pullorum testing done. Ducks DO NOT need to be tested for Pullorum.</b>

Exhibitors can tattoo breeding rabbits on their own or bring them to the June tattooing to have them tattooed at that time.
