

Jackson County Fair Beautification Project

RULES: All displays must have the club's name visibly posted. Clubs are encouraged to include the current year's fair theme. Displays must be cared for and kept in an attractive manner by the club during the fair. Items must be in place and registered in the Junior Fair Office by noon on Monday of the fair and removed by Saturday at 10am.

CLASSES:

- 1 Small Flower Pots, baskets, boxes or other containers (2 minimum)
- 2 Large Flower Pots, baskets, boxes or other containers (2 minimum)
- 3 Hanging Baskets (2 minimum)
- 4 Large Ground Displays (must be approved by Extension Educator)

Entries will be judged on the following criteria: Creativity, Quality and Visibility of Club Name.

Award ribbons/certificates will be given for the top five placings in each category,
