It is up to parents to determine the appropriateness of a Project Jumpstart for the development of their child. Cloverbuds can complete one activity or all – it is entirely up to the parent and the child's ability to complete the project.

Participants will need to enroll in the Cloverbud Project Jumpstart project in 4HOnline and submit with the club's book orders.
