Goals & Standards for the Jackson County 4-H Horse Committee Updated:

Standards of the Jackson County 4-H Horse Committee:

- 1. The Jackson County 4-H Horse Committee has implemented an ethics policy to deter activity that could cast a negative light on the Jackson County 4-H Horse Program. It is standard that Horse Committee members adhere to this policy, along with the Standards of Behavior set forth by Ohio 4-H.
- 2. The Jackson County 4-H Horse Committee's purpose is to continue to improve the 4-H Horse Program into one that is a model for other horse programs in the area.
- 3. The Jackson County 4-H Horse Committee's mission is to provide a fun, educational program for 4-H members to enjoy their horses and make lifelong friends.

Goals of the Jackson County 4-H Horse Committee:

- 1. Generate funds for the benefit of the Jackson County 4-H Horse Program, including (but not limited to) improvement of the Jackson County Fairgrounds' horse facilities, support for youth 4-H horse exhibitors, and scholarships for graduating seniors of the Jackson County 4-H Horse program.
- 2. Create comradery and community for those 4-H members & volunteers interested in horses and ponies.
- 3. Educate interested 4-H members, families, and volunteers about proper horse showmanship and care; to provide leadership to 4-H horse-related education in Jackson County.
