Market Hogs	May 5th	Tag-In ~ Saturday, May 5th Jackson County Fairgrounds (8-10am)	220-290 lbs.; Born After Jan. 1st; Maximum of 2 Shown; Castrated before 75 lbs Must Have 1/2" of Hair, Not Shaved; Pigs whose hair measures less than a half an inch of hair are subject to disqualification
Dairy Market Feeders	May 5th	Weigh-In ~ Saturday, May 5th Jackson County Fairgrounds (8-10am)	350-650 lbs.; Born between Jan. 1st & Mar. 1st; Maximum of 2 DMF Shown; Castrated, Horns Allowed Up to 2 inches
Market Lambs	May 5th	Weigh-In ~ Saturday, May 5th Jackson County Fairgrounds (8-10am)	85-145 lbs.; Born After Jan. 1st; Maximum of 2 Shown; Horns Allowed Up to 2 inches, Castrated before reaching 75 lbs, Lifiable Dock
Breeding Sheep	April 15th	N/A	Maximum of 2 entries per class; Must have a Lifiable Dock Horns of any length allowed if it is part of the breed standard.
Market Goats	May 5th	Weigh-In ~ Saturday, May 5th Jackson County Fairgrounds (8-10am)	60 lb. Minimum & Born After Jan. 1st (Market); Maximum of 2 Market Goats Shown; Male Goats Castrated;
Breeding & Dairy Goats	April 15th	N/A	Horns of any length allowed on goats only.
Market Chickens	Purchased Through The Extension Office	N/A	3-7 lbs.; Maximum of 4 Birds Shown (2 Pens). Cannot be comingled with other birds before the fair.
Breeding Poultry	June 23rd	Pullorum Testing ~ Saturday, June 23rd Jackson County Fairgrounds (7-10am)	Maximum of 2 entries per class. Cannot be comingled with other birds after pullorum testing. Breeding Turkeys must be purchased from a Pullorum-Free facility (provide documentation) or have pullorum testing done by a vet.
