Because 4-H programs are widely grant funded and/or funded with federal dollars, reporting participation and registration information is very important for our program's continuation and success. Please provide this information to your local 4-H Extension Educator ASAP for reporting and program tracking purposes. If any information changes throughout the program (i.e., students are added), please fill out the form again with the additional information and resubmit to your 4-H Educator.

- Please note that all collected data is stored safely and is protected by The Ohio State University and program policies.
- Please send home the attached photo release with your afterschool students. ODE requires that Ohio 4-H "prove" we are completing in-school and after-school programs through photo and video content. Once we have a signed photo release for a child, we will not have to have them sign another one again.
